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Overview

Overview

Welcome to Deltek Costpoint Mobile Time and Expense 2.5 Release Notes.

These release notes contain a summary of the following:

- Software Issues Resolved

Note: The official name of the application is *Costpoint Mobile Time and Expense*. This document uses it only at the first mention. Succeeding instances of the application name display Costpoint Mobile T&E.

In addition, the application name in the *Apple App Store* and *Google Play Store* displays Costpoint Time and Expense.

Note: SSL is a term commonly used when referring to both Secure Sockets Layer technology and its successor, Transport Layer Security (TLS). Although you may see references to SSL in this guide and in the application's user interface, all Deltek applications use current TLS protocols to provide protected connections between web servers and web browsers.

Features Not Supported

This section describes the Costpoint Time and Expense features that are not available in Costpoint Mobile T&E.

- Interim Charges: You cannot create interim charges in Costpoint Mobile T&E. However, you can charge interim charges already in the timesheets. Interim charge edit occurs upon timesheet signing.
- Hours Proration: Hours proration is supported, but the Day view is limited to entered hours display only. Prorated hours after signing the timesheet will display in the Summary view.
- **Timesheet Printing:** You will not be able to print timesheets. You will need to use browser-based timesheets.
- **Timesheet Comments**: You will not be able to enter or view the OVERALL timesheet comments and notes.
- Unhide Outstanding Expenses: You can only hide outstanding expenses displayed on the Outstanding Expenses tab. To display a hidden outstanding expense again in Costpoint Mobile T&E, you need to log into Costpoint, navigate to Time & Expense »
 Expense » Expense Reports » My Outstanding Expenses, and clear the Hide checkbox for that outstanding expense.

Mobile Device Requirements

The Costpoint Mobile T&E application supports mobile devices that run on the following operating systems:

Apple iOS 16 and higher

Android 11 and higher

In addition, you must have the following default browsers:

- Safari for Apple iOS devices
- Google Chrome for Android devices

Note: For Samsung devices, you must have the default Samsung Internet browser.

Issue with Microsoft Authenticator Using Face ID for Azure on iOS Devices

If you are using Two-Factor Authentication (2FA) with Microsoft Authenticator and Face ID on iOS devices, you may be stuck when trying to approve an authentication from Microsoft Azure.

This is a known issue with the Microsoft Authenticator application, and the workaround is to use PIN instead of Face ID with the application.

Prerequisites

Before you begin the installation and setup of Costpoint Mobile T&E, it is important to understand the following information:

Important: Information in this section does not apply to Cloud customers.

- You must install Costpoint Time & Expense 10.x and Costpoint Maintenance Release 8.1, at the minimum.
- If you are going to access Costpoint Mobile T&E from the internet, open a port in your firewall to access the Costpoint Time & Expense virtual directory, which will be installed on the IIS server. You must use the TLS 1.2 or TLS 1.3 protocol and configure the IIS server to support "Forward Secrecy" for all deployments.
- You must install Costpoint Mobile T&E on an IIS web server. You can use an existing IIS web server or your Costpoint web server, but not the embedded WebLogic web server.

Technical Considerations

You must meet the following requirements to run Costpoint Mobile T&E:

- You must install Costpoint Mobile T&E on an IIS server that is installed on Windows Server 2016 or Windows Server 2019.
- When using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL), you must have a certificate issued by a trusted certificate authority. You must not use self-signed certificates. Wildcard certificates are acceptable if they come from a trusted certificate authority.

Note:

 The Costpoint Mobile T&E URL has the format https://<server>/DeltekTouch/ Costpoint/TE, where <server> refers to the host name of your Costpoint Mobile T&E server.

- To comply with the new mobile application security requirements, the feature to populate the Costpoint Mobile T&E Server URL via email when logging on to the application for the first time is no longer supported. If you attempt to use this feature, the Costpoint Mobile T&E application will display an "unspecified error" message and will automatically close.
- The Costpoint Mobile T&E installer installs PHP 8.2.13 in this release.

- 8.1+: The feature is available to users of Costpoint 8.1.x and 8.2.x.
- 8.2+: The feature is available to users of Costpoint 8.2 and higher.

Support for Timesheet Class Filter on Timesheet Search (8.1+)

When performing a timesheet search on the Timesheet Search screen, you can now utilize a timesheet class as a filtering criterion.

Tapping **Timesheet Class** displays the Timesheet Class screen, where you can select from a list of timesheet classes defined by your company.

Note: The **Timesheet Class** field is available if you are using Costpoint 8.1.25 and higher and Costpoint 8.2.4 and higher. To check your Costpoint version, see **About (Deltek Costpoint)** on the <u>Settings screen</u>.

Ability to Search Missing Timesheets (8.2+)

You can now use the **Missing** field on the Timesheet Search screen to perform a search on missing timesheets using the Costpoint Mobile T&E application.

When this field is set to **On**, all the selections made in the **Timesheet Status** field are cleared. When you tap any of the options in the **Timesheet Status** field, this field is set to **Off**.

When you search for missing timesheets, you must specify a value in the **Period** field. When your search identifies missing timesheets, the application will display a list of these timesheets. However, you will not be able to select or review any of the timesheets in the list.

Dashboard Item Removal (8.1+)

The charts that were previously available on the Dashboard screen had been moved to the tabs on the Timesheet-Summary screen in version 2.4.

To complete the enhancement, the Dashboard item has been removed from the following areas in the Costpoint Mobile T&E application starting from version 2.5:

- Costpoint Mobile T&E menu
- Home Page field on the Settings screen

Technology-Related Updates

Support for PHP 8.2.13 (8.1+)

The Costpoint Mobile T&E Server has been upgraded to support PHP 8.2.13.

ICR Plugin Update (8.1+)

The Intelligent Character Recognition (ICR) plugin for processing and data extraction has been updated to its latest version.

Software Issues Resolved

Incorrect Label for the Requests Icon

Defect 2050325

Description: The **Requests** icon on the Leave screen had an incorrect label, leading to confusion for some users. When you tapped the icon, it displayed the Leave Requests screen with all the leave requests you had submitted.

Customers Impacted: This defect affects all customers using the Leave feature.

Workaround Before Fix: None.

Additional Notes: The icon label has been changed from **Pending Requests** to **Requests**. This change is also reflected in the following help topics:

- Leave
- View Leave Requests
- <u>Contents of the Screen Display</u>
